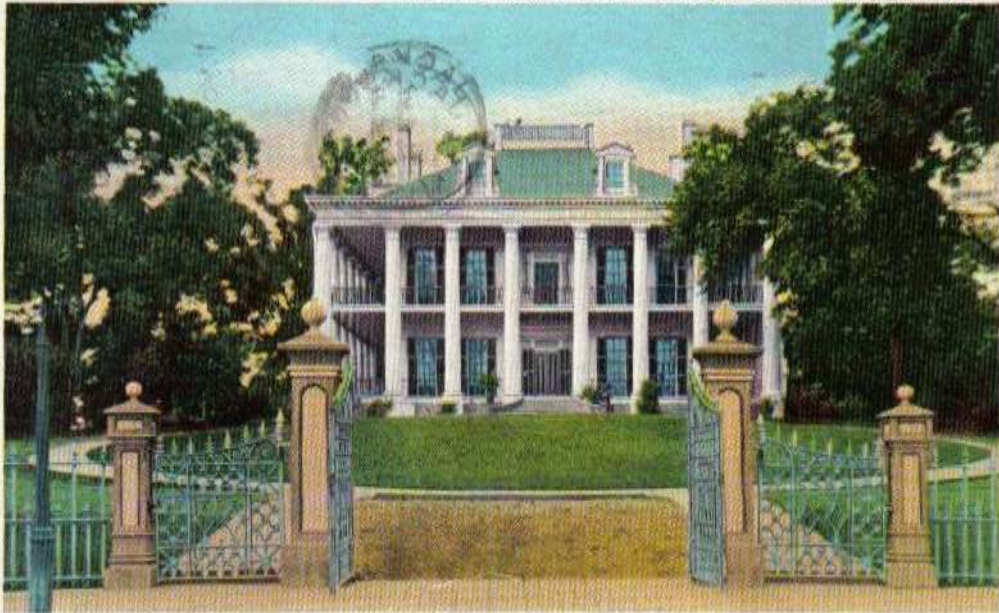


"Dunleith," Residence of J. N. Carpenter, Esq., Natchez, Miss.
